This “American Studies Over Seas” Global Humanities Faculty Seminar hopes to develop a model for an international American Studies practice that reflects both the complexity and the richness of the field in and beyond the national space of the United States, at the same time that it respects unique research interests across distinct national and regional spaces both “at home” and “abroad.”

It builds on the legacy of the faculty exchange program (1995–2006) between the University of Lisbon's English Studies Department (ULICES), at the School of Arts and Humanities (FLUL), and Georgetown University's Program in American Studies and Departments of English and History, and on the promise of a new scholarly publication of the same title honoring two of U Lisboa's faculty leaders, Professors Teresa Cid and Teresa Alves, who also led the creation of the abovementioned exchange program. The project hopes to establish a blueprint for exchange going forward that prioritizes American Studies across disciplines and related fields and inter-disciplines, as reflected by faculty on our two campuses.
