**Bolsa de Doutoramento ET - CEAUL/FLUL (Estudos de Tradução)**

Applications are open until **14 October 2020** for **1** (one) position of **Doctoral Candidate** (Ph.D. fellow) in **Translation Studies** at the University of Lisbon Centre for English Studies (<http://ulices.letras.ulisboa.pt/en/>).

**The selected applicant:**

- will be offered a Ph.D. scholarship, renewable up to four years (1064.00€ per month);
- will carry out research necessary for a successful completion of the proposed Ph.D. project at CEAUL/ULICES (located in Lisbon, Portugal);
- will enrol on a Ph.D. programme in Translation Studies at the School of Arts and Humanities of the University of Lisbon;
- will take part in projects and activities organized by CEAUL/ULICES;

Topics available for research include, but are not limited to: censorship, indirect translation, retranslation, revision, multimodality, translation norms, translation strategies, translator status and training in different translation domains (audiovisual, institutional, literary, technical, etc.).

This position is funded by FCT - Fundação para a Ciência e Tecnologia/MCTES under the Collaboration Protocol for the Financing of the Multiannual Plan for Research Grants for Doctoral Students, celebrated between the Fundação para a Ciência e Tecnologia and the University of Lisbon Centre for English Studies.

### Admission requirements:

- BA and MA in English and American Studies (or neighbouring areas, including Translation Studies).
- Near-native command of English and advanced level of Portuguese.

Applications, written in English or Portuguese, should include all documents listed in section 4.2. of the official announcement ([\[Link to PT version\]](#)) and should include:

- Cover letter with personal details (date and place of birth, passport number, current address, etc.);
- CV (including list of relevant publications);
- Research proposal (incl. project title; name and affiliation of prospective supervisors; main research questions; background and literature review; research aims, plan, material and method; approximate timeline (for four years); a short bibliography; a brief explanation as to how the proposed research is aligned with ULICES's mission and strategic areas of research);
- Motivation letter;
- Copies of the required BA and MA degrees (incl. details on final grades). In case of integrated master degrees without separate grades for the 1st and 2nd cycle of study, the applicants should provide the final grades of both cycles, as well as the total number of ECTS; If the BA or MA degree was obtained abroad, the successful applicant must undertake all the formal obligations to ensure that the degree is recognized and/or converted to the Portuguese grading scale before the research contract is celebrated.
